
Cycles of squatting in Barcelona

1. Introduction: this investigation about squatting is based on critical and qualitative analysis. We discuss squatting cycles basing ourselves on our historical account of Barcelona's struggles, while relating them to wider institutional and socio-political contexts. We also assess the impacts of the squatting movement on the political agenda of each cycle.


